Statement of Understanding:

Emerald Bay staff will make sure bathrooms and showers are sanitary and stocked, however it is the responsibility of every guest (student and adult) to ensure that their sleeping accommodations remain clean and tidy.

Our instructors will conduct all scheduled sessions, consisting of 4 2-hour long day time sessions and 1 2-hour long evening session per full day. Our staff will provide a nutritious and delicious meal for breakfast, lunch and dinner. Please make sure food allergies or dietary restrictions are listed on the medical sections, so that we can prepare for those needs in advance.

Please note the following responsibilities:

1. Adult chaperones will remain with their assigned student groups for all activities, including snorkeling, kayaking, and stand up paddleboards.
2. Adult chaperones are expected to supervise students during free time, meals, and in between sessions.
3. As the group leader, you are responsible for assigning the students into 8 student cabin groups (girls/boy separate). One boy cabin and one girl cabin will be combined for class sessions, for a maximum of 16 students.
4. Emerald Bay will respect and adopt the school's policy regarding use of electronic device. However, Emerald Bay does not assume responsibility for lost or stolen property.
5. Alcoholic beverages or their consumption are not permitted at any time while staying at Emerald Bay.
6. Adult chaperones are responsible for enforcing lights out and cabin behaviors.
7. Smoking is only permitted in designated areas and only by adult chaperones.
8. Any returned checks at any time, will be assessed a \$30 fee.
