The Director is responsible for day-to-day execution of programs, ensuring standards of instruction, scheduling coverage of all activities, managing and supervising staff, and coordinating resource allocation with budget accountability.

- Provide overall supervision and leadership of the Emerald Bay Outdoor Academy Program.
- Supervise Outdoor Academy staff including staff scheduling & payroll assistance.
- Plan and facilitate all staff training.
- Recruit, hire, and train Outdoor Academy Staff.
- Coordinate and consult with Emerald Bay Management Team on aspects of program operations: Marine Center, Kitchen, Facilities, etc.
- Supervise curriculum development and implementation.
- Provide program evaluation for youth and adult participants.
- Develop and maintain program operational materials.
- Oversee maintenance of all program equipment.
- Work with the Grants Administrator to seek and apply for new funding sources.
- Coordinate and oversee the Emerald Bay Outdoor Academy Advisory Team.
- Coordinate the annual EBOA Community Appreciation Weekend.
