

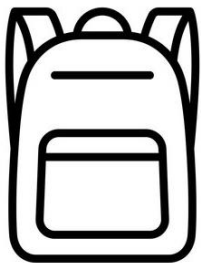
Emerald Bay Outdoor Academy Packing List for Students and Adults

Schools should select a colored yarn or ribbon to attach to each item of their gear for easy identification, as the boat may be shared by multiple groups.

Guests must carry their own luggage on and off the boat and several hundred yards to their sleeping accommodations. Therefore, all guests are advised to bring only what they can carry. Please mark all clothing and items with first and last names. Please pack enough clothing for the duration of the trip as laundry facilities are not available.

Note: Clothing WILL get dirty! Pack swimsuits and towel on top as all participants will need to change on Arrival Day for the Float Test which is during Orientation.
